Leap Into Spring With The HCMA Annual Meeting and Potluck Supper

We're pleased to announce that Old Mill Creek mayor Tim Smith will be our guest speaker, sharing the fascinating history of the famed Lipizzan stallions, which his family first brought to our area in the 1950s, eventually building the world's largest herd — once numbering more than 600 — of these remarkable horses.

Tim's discussion is particularly timely, as it coincides with the recent publication of "The Perfect Horse" by Elizabeth Letts, a bestseller recounting "The Daring U.S. Mission to Rescue the Priceless Stallions Kidnapped by the Nazis" involving Gen. George S. Patton.

The Tempel Lipizzans are, perhaps, the most visible and distinctive symbol of our area, a beautiful representation of what makes Millburn and Old Mill Creek so special. Please join us to learn more about these extraordinary horses, to enjoy good company, and to support the HMCA and the preservation of our unique history.

Martin's General Store Museum

Since 1985, the HMCA has maintained the old Martin's General Store, in the heart of the Millburn Historic District, as a museum preserving the history of our unique area. The store was generously left to the HMCA, along with an endowment for its preservation, by Mr. Richard Martin, whose family had owned and operated the store since 1910. Built in 1862, the building contains a collection of historic artifacts related to the history of our area since its settlement in the mid 19th century The museum is open by appointment only.

IMPORTANT MEMORIAL DAY UPDATE

The Board of Director, after much thought and deliberation, has decided that we are no longer able to organize and host the Memorial Day service at Millburn Cemetery. The Gurnee American Legion, which has graciously participated in our services, is faced with declining membership and can no longer participate.
